

RULES FOR USING THE OUTDOOR INFLATABLE WATER PLAYGROUND

§ 1

1. These Regulations contain supplementary and specific provisions specifying the rules for the use of an outdoor inflatable water playground for children, along with the water attractions placed in it (hereinafter jointly referred to as the "inflatable water playground"), located in the swimming pool area separated in the Chochołów Thermal Bath Facility.
2. The inflatable water playground is open during the holiday season at scheduled times and is intended for sports and recreation.
3. The inflatable water playground and its attractions are available only for children aged 5 to 13, with a height between min. 100 cm to max. 150 cm, who can swim or use floating equipment and are under the constant care and supervision of a parent or adult guardian.
4. The inflatable water playground, together with all the water attractions placed there, constitute an integral part of the swimming pool area. All persons using them are obliged to comply with both these Regulations and the Regulations for using the swimming pool area. The guardian of a child using the inflatable water playground and its attractions is obliged to read these Regulations, information boards, signs and instructions for using water attractions before using them and pass on the safety rules to the child and then supervise compliance with their provisions.
5. Each User is also obliged to strictly comply with the provisions of the main Regulations of the Facility.
6. In all matters not covered by these Regulations, the other Regulations in force in the Chochołów Thermal Bath Facility shall apply, particularly the provisions of the main Regulations of the Facility.

§ 2

1. Guardians are obliged to strictly and constantly supervise children when using the inflatable water playground and its water attractions and to stay in a place where they can constantly see the children and are seen by them.
2. Participants of organised groups, including children and youth of school age, may use the inflatable water playground only in the presence of a group guardian supervising them.
3. The inflatable water playground, particularly the slides placed in it, is not intended for people with cardiovascular, respiratory, skeletal, neurological and gastric dysfunctions and those who are particularly sensitive to sudden overloads.
4. Children can use the inflatable water playground in swimsuits without sharp elements (zippers, studs, etc.).
5. Before using the inflatable water playground, remove all jewellery and ornaments, particularly watches, bracelets, chains, necklaces, rings, earrings, glasses, ornaments and hairpins, and all other items, including those containing sharp elements. Removed items, mobile phones, music players, money and other valuable or sharp items, must be left with parents or guardians.
6. Up to 15 people can use the inflatable water playground simultaneously. In the event of a high density of children, a staff member or a lifeguard may divide children into groups and let them into the playground for a limited time.

§ 3

1. When using the inflatable water playground, it is forbidden to cause situations that threaten your safety, the safety of other people using this playground and the area of the swimming pool area, or that may cause an accident, in particular:
 - using the device contrary to its intended use;
 - jumping from other objects to the elements of the inflatable water playground or from its elements to other objects;
 - climbing on the elements of the inflatable water playground in prohibited places, in particular on the side walls of the slide and climbing on other structural elements not intended for this purpose;
 - bringing sharp and glass objects;
 - eating and drinking or chewing gum in the inflatable water playground;
 - starting the slide when there are other people in the downhill chute or on the slide landing site;
 - pushing people into the downhill chute;
 - performing a slide in pairs, in a group and with small children, especially those held in the arms on the stomach;
 - bringing any objects into the gutter and sliding down with objects that may cause damage to the body or the device;
 - jumping into the run-up slide chute;
 - stopping and standing inside the downhill chute;
 - climbing on balustrades, handrails and structural elements;
 - entering the downhill chute from the side of the end piece and climbing inside the chute towards the starting point;
 - staying within the slide landing zone;
 - using the inflatable water playground and its attractions if the access is closed with a chain, rope or other visible way;
 - adults not taking care of children staying on the inflatable water playground;
 - being near the blowers that drive the device.
2. When entering the slide platform, be especially careful: it is forbidden to run, push, force a place in the queue, etc.
3. Right-hand traffic is allowed on the stairs.
4. Only one person may be on the starting platform.
5. Starting the descent is allowed only when no other Users are in the landing area or within the slide.
6. The descent takes place individually.
7. The only allowed descent positions are:
 - stable sitting position with the face turned in the direction of travel, with straight legs and arms placed next to the body ;
 - lying on the back with straight legs, directed in the direction of travel and arms placed along the body.

The selected position must be maintained throughout the descent. Other downhill positions are prohibited.

8. After the descent, you must immediately leave the slide landing area.

9. All persons using the inflatable water playground are obliged to strictly follow and comply with the instructions, commands and sound signals of lifeguards and employees of the swimming pool area, as well as announcements made through loudspeakers.

§ 4

The Company reserves the right to change the opening hours and completely close the inflatable water playground at any time, at its discretion, particularly due to bad weather conditions, necessary technical or other works.

§ 5

1. In the event of an accident caused by non-compliance with these Regulations, the User bears all responsibility.
2. All persons violating public order or the provisions of these Regulations will be removed from the area of the inflatable water playground, as well as from the area of the swimming pool area.
3. Other basic rules for using the Facility, as well as the rules of liability and obligations of the Customers, are regulated by the Regulations for using the swimming pool area and the main Regulations of the Facility.
