REGULATIONS FOR USING THE SALT CAVE /NON-TEXTILE/

§ 1

- 1. These Regulations contain supplementary and specific provisions specifying the rules for using the salt cave /non-textile/, located in the sauna zone separated in the Chochołów Thermal Baths Facility.
- 2. The salt cave is an integral part of the sauna zone, and all persons using it are obliged to comply with both these Regulations and the Saunarium Regulations.
- 3. Each User is also obliged to strictly comply with the provisions of the main Regulations of the Facility.
- 4. In all matters not covered by these Regulations, the other Regulations in force in the Chochołów Thermal Baths Facility shall apply, particularly the provisions of the main Regulations of the Facility.
- 5. Each person using the salt cave is obliged to read the content of these Regulations before using it and then comply with its provisions. It is also required to read the information boards available within the grotto.

§ 2

- 1. The salt cave is available to Users entitled to use the sauna zone in accordance with the rules applicable in this zone, taking into account the following reservations.
- 2. The salt cave is a room made entirely of salt blocks, equipped with brine graduation towers.
- 3. The salt cave can only be used by healthy people or people whose ailments are not contraindications to this type of treatment.
- 4. Each person using the salt cave should consult a doctor regarding contraindications to using this form of recreation. Persons with an unstable health condition, in particular with:
 - claustrophobia;
 - hyperthyroidism;
 - advanced cancers;
 - acute tuberculosis;
 - other acute inflammatory conditions;
 - pregnant women;

should use the salt cave with extreme caution only after prior consultation with their doctor.

- 5. The use of the salt cave is at the User's own risk.
- 6. The Company and its Management are not responsible for the health effects of staying in the salt cave.

δ3

- 1. Before entering the salt cave room, you should:
 - take care of physiological needs;
 - wash the whole body in the shower with soap and then wipe dry.
- 2. At least two people can stay in the salt cave.
- 3. In case of feeling unwell, leave the grotto immediately and immediately report to a staff member.
- 4. Wearing glasses and contact lenses is not recommended. In the event of failure to comply with this requirement, the User must take into account the risk of damage to the glasses/contact lenses,

for which the Company and its Management are not responsible if they occur. When staying in the salt cave with corrective glasses (at the User's own risk), these glasses must be fixed to prevent them from falling.

§ 4

- 1. When using the salt cave, it is forbidden to cause situations that threaten one's safety, the safety of other people using the cave and the area of the sauna area, or that may cause an accident, in particular:
 - using the grotto if the access is closed with a chain, rope or other visible way;
 - bringing any objects into the cave, including it is forbidden to bring and consume drinks or food;
 - littering and polluting the grotto area;
 - destroying the devices and equipment of the cave;
 - making noise, disturbing other Users staying in the grotto;
 - moving movable equipment without the consent of the Staff;
 - using the grotto equipment contrary to its intended purpose;
 - touching the cave walls;
 - taking salt crystals out of the cave.
- 2. All persons using the salt cave must strictly follow and comply with the instructions, commands and sound signals of lifeguards and employees of the sauna zone, as well as messages given through loudspeakers.

§ 5

- 1. In the event of an accident caused by non-compliance with these Regulations, the User bears all responsibility.
- 2. All persons violating public order or the provisions of these Regulations will be removed from the salt cave and the Saunarium area.
- 3. Saunarium zone and the main Regulations of the Facility.
